Town to host a meeting on youth sailing at Alhambra!



Mount Pleasant Recreation Committee to host public meeting at Alhambra Hall to explore sailing program feasibility

MOUNT PLEASANT, SC (March 19, 2008) – On Thursday, March 27, residents of Mount Pleasant will get to voice their opinions on the potential launch of a sailing program at Alhambra Hall. Scheduled by Recreation Committee members Gary Santos, Paul Gawrych and Billy Swails, the public meeting will begin at 7:00 p.m. for a discussion about the feasibility of a youth sailing program at Alhambra Hall.

“Sailing is an integral part of the Mount Pleasant experience,” said Councilmember Santos. “Mount Pleasant is essentially a large peninsula bordered by a harbor, a river and the Intracoastal Waterway. We are water-bound and we should allow our children the opportunity to experience one of our coastal town’s favorite past-times and sport. Charleston Community Sailing (a non-profit organization promoting high school competitive sailing) spoke at our March Recreation meeting and clearly stated that a youth sailing program at the new Memorial Waterfront Park would not be an option due to safety concerns. Alhambra Hall, with its easy access to water and protection from the elements and marine traffic, offers a feasible alternative. We would like open a dialogue with our residents to explore our options.”

The meeting will take place at Alhambra Hall and will cover topics ranging from dock size and location, to programming, cost, and hours of operation. For more information on the proposed youth sailing program come to Alhambra Hall and join the discussion on Thursday, March 27, at 7:00 p.m.
